The MISSION of QCS is to be an academic institution of excellence, working with the Christian home and Bible believing churches to train each student in the knowledge of God and the scriptural way of life.

Understanding the purpose or mission of QCS, we believe the Word of God provides insights for daily living. Applying these truths in a consistent manner will enrich our lives. As a student at Quincy Christian School, I have carefully read the Code of Conduct and the student handbook and will strive to develop the following standards in my life:

1. Actively work at building and nourishing a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Studying God's Word, maintaining an active prayer life, worshipping with fellow believers, making one's self-accountable to others, and sharing one's faith are vital components of a growing relationship.
2. Think about things that are true, noble, right and pure (Philippians 4:8). Avoid influences that distract one's mind, recognizing that what occupies the mind will sooner or later determine one's speech and actions.
3. Choose your friends and associations carefully (Psalm 1:1). One tends to become like the people with whom one associates.
4. Understand the progressive nature of sinful activities.
5. Encourage one another and build each other up (1 Thessalonians 5:11).
6. Avoid destructive, unkind and unnecessary words or deeds.
7. Take care that one's attitude and actions positively influence others, and do not become a stumbling block (Romans 14:13).
8. Communicate directly with one another in the spirit of love (Matthew 18:15-17). Avoid gossip, talking behind one another's back or holding bitterness.
9. Respect authority (1 Peter 2:17). Honor God, obey and respect the laws of our country, the standards of one's parents, and the expectations of one's school communities.
10. Be honest and above reproach (Proverbs 8:7). Always speak the truth and avoid even the appearance of dishonesty. Refrain from stealing, lying, cheating and gambling.
11. Care for your body as a "temple of God" (1 Corinthians 6:19). Refrain from the possession and use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, illegal drugs, abusing prescription drugs or any other harmful substance or activities.
12. Maintain biblical standards of morality (1 Co 6:18). Save sex for what and when God intended, within the sanctity of marriage.
13. Demonstrate self-control (James 1:9). Be quick to learn, slow to speak, and slow to become angry. When you sin, seek forgiveness and make amends.

I have read the Statement of Faith adopted by the school, and although it may not be my specific belief model, I recognize it represents the basic truths common to most born-again Christians. I recognize the Bible as the only inspired, infallible, authoritative, in-errant Word of God. I will learn to defend my beliefs with Biblical truth recognizing these are areas where believers may see the same passage differently. I will treat others with respect, even in areas where we may disagree in our understanding of Biblical truth.
